Jurisdictional Inspection Services:

Chubb Equipment Breakdown Risk Engineers (EBREs) conduct jurisdictional inspections of pressure retaining objects in compliance with the State of New Jersey's Bureau of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Compliance. The provisions of N.J.A.C 12.90 require:

- Boilers be inspected annually, internally and/or externally, as boiler construction permits.
- Refrigeration/air conditioning equipment (generally over 18-tons) be inspected annually.
- Unfired pressure vessels be inspected triennially.
