## School Leaders Errors & Omissions Claims Handling to Move In-House with NJSIG Starting July 1

**Exciting News!** Effective July 1, 2024, the NJSIG Claims Department will begin adjusting all E&O claims made and reported to NJSIG on or after 7/1/24. While Summit Risk Services did a great job handling claims for our members, we, at NJSIG, know *no one takes care of our members like we do and are happy to take on this responsibility on the E&O line.*

NJSIG will retain (self-insure) the first \$1,000,000 in primary E&O coverage in lieu of Lexington Insurance Company (AIG) effective 7/1/24. **Members must report all known losses and incidents which may give rise to a potential claim to Summit Risk Services on behalf of AIG before 7/1/2024 as losses occurring prior to 7/1/24 will be excluded from coverage under the 2024-2025 NJSIG claims-made coverage document.** No substantive changes or reductions in coverage have been made to the 2024-2025 NJSIG coverage document. Effective 7/1/24, the NJSIG Claims Department will begin adjusting all E&O claims made and reported to NJSIG on or after 7/1/24. Summit Risk Services will continue to adjust all E&O claims made and reported prior to 7/1/24. Please report all new claims made on or after 7/1/24 directly to NJSIG (not Summit Risk Services).

Remember, Summit Risk Services will continue to adjust all E&O claims made and reported prior to 7/1/24. Please report all new claims made on or after 7/1/24 directly to NJSIG. We are eager to begin this change and are looking forward to having more control over claims handling and the possibility of adding to our surplus during successful policy years.

Just a reminder, all districts that have school board leader liability or "SBLL" coverage, also referred to as Errors and Omissions or "E&O" coverage, with NJSIG are entitled to use NJSIG's Employment Practices Hotline Attorney (NEPHA) and its accompanying online employment resources, at no additional charge!
