COASTAL STORM EXPECTED BETWEEN SUNDAY AND MONDAY



Weekend Weather - Costal Storm Brewing

We're closely monitoring a developing coastal storm system expected to impact New Jersey between Sunday and Monday. Forecast models now strongly indicate that areas across the state will experience some level of impact.

Here's what we do know:

- Rain is coming. Expect wet conditions Sunday and Monday, with the heaviest rainfall likely in southern and coastal areas.
- It will be windy. Gusts will pick up during the same period, especially along the coast.

Important for school districts:

- Many schools will be closed on Monday for the holiday. Please assign staff to inspect school buildings during and after the storm to check for leaks, flooding, power outages, or other damage.

Preparation tips:

- Secure outdoor equipment, signage, and anything that could become a hazard in strong winds.
- Double-check power sources.
- Review communication plans to keep staff and students informed of closures or emergencies.
- Make sure your facilities team knows how to respond if flooding or damage occurs.

Post-event tips:

- Prioritize safety first—avoid sending staff or students into unsafe conditions.
- Coordinate with local emergency services as needed.
- Document any damage with photos and reports.
- Communicate early and clearly with your district about any extended closures or changes to schedules.
