NJSIG is here to help your district stay proactive. As part of your NJSIG membership, members have access to a variety of **value-added safety and risk management services**, including:

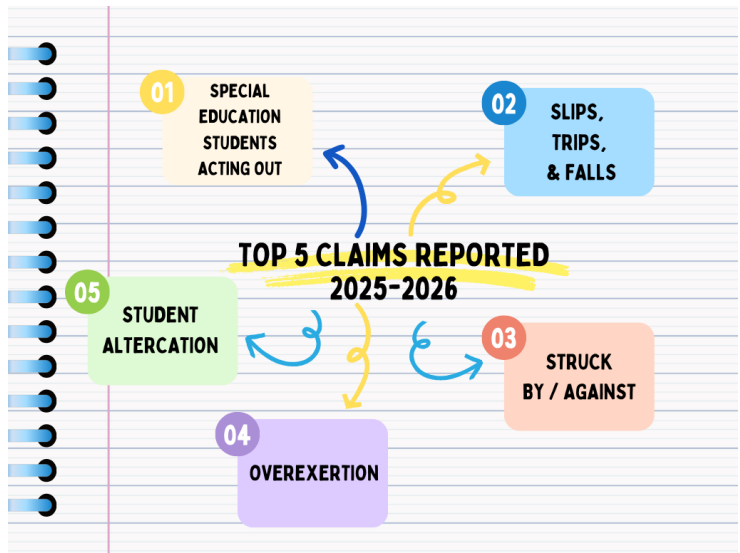

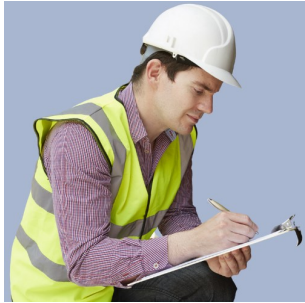

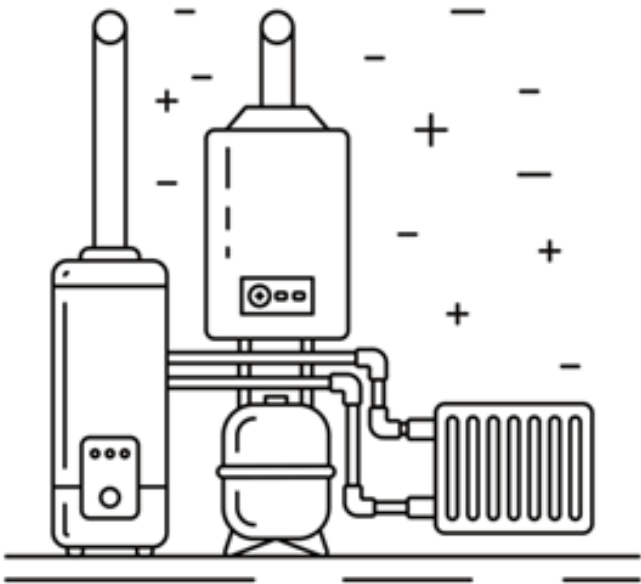

Strengthen Your Boiler Safety Knowledge Before Heating Season!

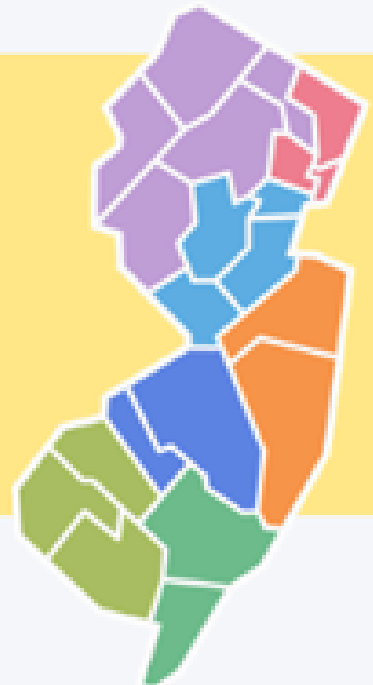
